

**VILLAGE OF SHOREWOOD
50/50 PARKWAY TREE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM**

The trees shown below give general descriptions of the character and habitat of the species.



Callery Pear

Callery Pear is a small tree growing to only 30'-40' at mature height. The tree is tolerant of dry to moist, well-drained soils. In the spring it blooms with white flowers, and has a purple-red fall color.

Varieties: 'Chanticleer', 'Aristocrat'

Crabapple

Crabapple Trees should be planted where overhead utility lines are present. They prefer well-drained soils and should be well watered the first year after planting. Avoid excessively moist or low areas. Beautiful flowers in the spring are replaced by small green leaves throughout the summer months. Crabapples have diverse growth habits or tree shapes. Be sure to pick a rounded, upright (columnar) or pyramidal variety. Flowering crabapples vary greatly in size. At maturity, certain cultivars will only attain a height of eight feet, most flowering crabapples reach mature heights of 15 to 25 feet. Due to their versatility, crabapples make excellent choices for use around homes, schools, parks, public and commercial buildings, and in highway plantings.



Varieties: 'Coralburst', 'Golden Raindrops', 'Pink Princess', 'Prairiefire', 'Purple Prince', 'Red Jewel', 'Sargent'



Elm

The broad arching habit of the hybrid elm tree still mimics the classic elm. Dutch Elm Disease resistant, hybrid elms grow to 60' tall and have a nice light yellow to yellow green fall color. The tree can tolerate wet sites and a range of soil pH.

Varieties: 'Valley Forge', 'Princeton', 'New Harmony', 'Homestead', 'Morton', 'Morton Glossy'

Ginkgo

Ginkgo has fan-shaped leaves and good yellow fall color. Growing to a height of 50'-80', it can tolerate drought, heat, air pollution and salt. Soil types include dry to moist, well-drained soils. Female species are not permitted due to the harsh smell of their fruit. All species planted will be of a variety that is male only.

Varieties: 'Autumn Gold', 'Magyar', or 'Princeton Sentry'



Common Hackberry

Hackberry survives best in moist, well-drained soils, but can tolerate wet soils. Tolerant of salt, wind, dry sites, and alkaline soils, this tree adapts well to its environment. Fall color is green-yellow and grows to heights of 50'-90'.

Varieties: 'Chicagoland', 'Windy City'

Kentucky Coffeetree

Kentucky Coffeetree can tolerate dry to moist, well-drained soils, and is salt and drought tolerant. The varieties selected are male only and do not produce seed pods. In the spring the flowers are greenish white pyramidal spikes and the fall color is yellow orange. This tree can reach up to 75' feet in height and is a fast grower.

Varieties: 'Espresso', 'Prairie Titan'



Linden

The Linden species like well-drained soils and can tolerate alkaline soils. They grow to 60'-80' tall, and have fragrant flowers in early summer. Fall foliage is brown-green.

Varieties: American, 'Glenleven', Littleleaf, 'Redmond', or 'Greenspire'

Oak

Bur Oak or Swamp White Oak, Chinquapin. Oak trees are more sensitive to moving environments, and must be planted in the spring. At maturity, they can reach up to 75' in height. Oaks typically tolerate wet and dry soil, salt, and wind. They can survive in any soil condition, and are slow growing. The fall color ranges from brown-green to yellow.



Red maple *Sugar maple*

Maple trees can reach up to 50' in height, and prefer moist, well-drained soils. Fall color is yellow to orange to red for Sugar Maples and red for Red Maples. Maples are fast growers.

Varieties: Sugar Maple 'Green Mountain', 'Legacy', 'Crescendo' Red Maple 'Autumn Flame', 'Franksred'

Thornless Honeylocust

Thorn-less Honey locust tolerates moist, well-drained soils, drought conditions, and salt. The rounded, open, habit has small compound leaves that provide light shade. Fall color is yellow. Mature height of the species is 40'-70'.

Varieties: 'Skyline', 'Shademaster', 'Suncole'



Turkish Filbert

Turkish Filbert prefers moist, well-drained soil to dry conditions. When the tree is young it has a pyramidal shape that gradually changes to an oval shape. The fall color is green-yellow and mature height is 40'-50'. This tree must be watered the first few summers until established, and then it becomes very drought tolerant.
