

## **Resident Radar Program**



Any Shorewood resident concerned with speeding motorists in their neighborhood may work in partnership with the Shorewood Police by participating in the Resident Radar Program. This program allows citizens of Shorewood to obtain radar equipment and receive training to conduct a self-initiated traffic radar study. Any interested resident will be provided a radar and log sheet where suspected speeding vehicles can be verified and recorded. The Shorewood Police Department will then send warning letters to owners of the speeding vehicles; requesting their compliance with residential speed limits. ## **Keep Kids Alive Drive 25 Yard Sign Program**



The Shorewood Police Department is offering another approach for residents concerned with speeding motorists. The Keep Kids Alive Drive 25 Yard Sign Program offers neighborhoods direct involvement in slowing vehicles down and providing safer streets. Any interested Shorewood resident can obtain 10 (24"x18") Keep Kids Alive Drive 25 yard signs for 30 days, to disperse between willing neighbors. The signs shall be placed in each resident's parkway during daylight hours and removed at dusk. This public awareness effort should make an immediate impact on speeding drivers in your neighborhood.
